I also coach an adult class one night a week. I'm qualified to coach up to level 7 and I'm currently working on my advanced course paperwork. I'm also a qualified elementary judge meaning I can judge up to level 3.

I finished school last year and since then I have been concentrating on my training and coaching. I'm still unsure what I want to do with my life outside of gymnastics but for now I'm not going anywhere so I guess I'll just live in the gym.

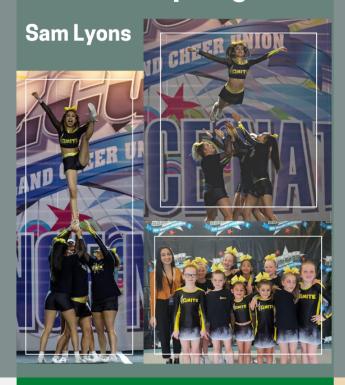
